What are Mopeds?

Mopeds are two wheeled, engine-powered vehicle with pedal.
In Japan, mopeds are not categorized as bicycle but as motorcycle.

To ride a "Moped" on the road, the followings are required



- ① To have a driver's licence.
- ② To wear a helmet.
- ③ To install parts such as headlights and indicators.
- ④ To have compulsory automobile liability insurance.
- ⑤ To show a license plate on the rear side.



**If you drive an illegal "Moped" on the road,
you could be punished by up to 3 years in prison or
fined up to 500,000 yen.**
