






Japanese Weasel (Mustela itatsi)

Kaisho Forest Nature Walk Etiquette

(Martes nelampus)



Do not enter wetlands and woods coming off from route on the map. Do not catch animals or pick plants.

Do not introduce outside plants and animals to the forest.

Do not frighten the animals.

Pets are not allowed in the forest.

Take your garbage with you.

The use of fire in any form is strictly prohibited.

Camping and barbeques are prohibited.

Be aware that toilets are not provided along walking path.

(Toilets are available at the Kaisho forest parking lot and the SATOYAMA satellite.)

Bring enough food and water (water fountains are not provided.)
